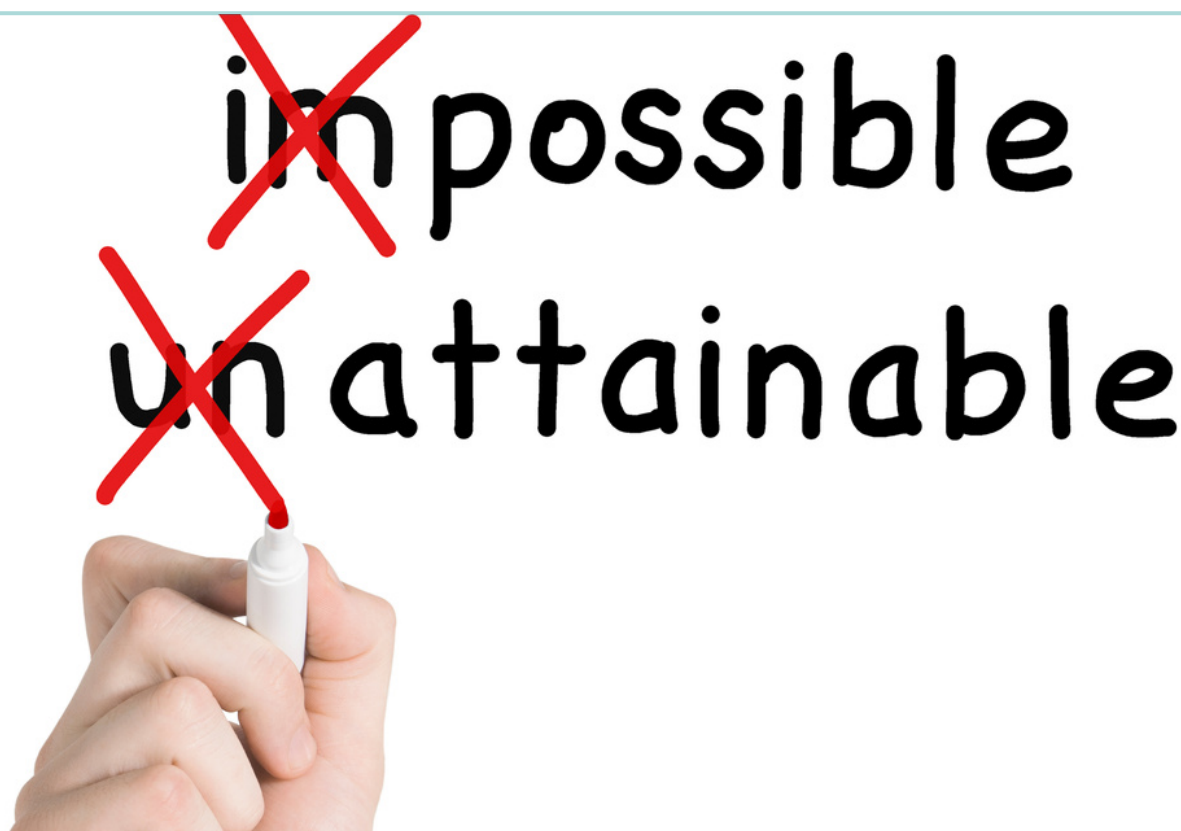
# Foster Collaboration
